

HOLIDAY HOMEWORK

I - ENVIRONMENTAL STUDIES

1. Growing a Plant Activity

Environment Day (5th June)

Student will grow a plant with the help of a seed and will observe its growth and will create a growth journal either by writing or drawing what happen each day.

Objective: Learn how plants grow and understand how we can help them grow by taking care of them.

Material Required

- A small pot or container (with drainage holes)
- Soil (garden soil or potting mix)
- A small plant seed (like a sunflower, beans, or marigold)
- Water
- A spoon or small shovel (to put the soil in the pot)
- A place with sunlight (like a windowsill)

Steps to grow a plant

1. Prepare Your Pot:

Take your small pot or container and fill it halfway with soil. Make sure the pot has small holes at the bottom so the water can drain out.

2. Plant the Seed:

Make a small hole in the middle of the soil using your finger or a spoon. Place your seed inside the hole and cover it lightly with more soil.

3. Water the Seed:

Water the soil gently. Make sure the soil is damp, but not too wet. Watering the plant too much can drown it!

4. Find a Sunny Spot:

Place the pot in a spot where it will get plenty of sunlight every day, like a windowsill or balcony.

5. Observe the Growth:

Every day, check the plant. Look for any changes and record what you see in your **Plant Growth Journal** (which you will make below!).

6. Be Patient:

Plants grow slowly, so be patient! Over the next few days and weeks, you'll see your plant starting to grow from the soil. Watch how the roots spread, the stem rises, and the leaves start to appear!

Your Plant Growth Journal:


Keep track of your plant's growth by writing down or drawing what happens each day in an A4 paper and stick it on the Homework notebook.

Example of how to keep your journal:

- Day 1: "I planted my seed today. I put it in the soil and watered it."
- Day 3: "I see a little sprout! It's so tiny, but it looks like it's growing."
- Day 7: "The plant is getting taller now. I can see some tiny leaves."

Important point to include

- Date
- What you see happening (growth, leaves, color of the plant, etc.)
- How you are taking care of it (watering, sunlight)
